The Glugs want to help him – and all have a try.

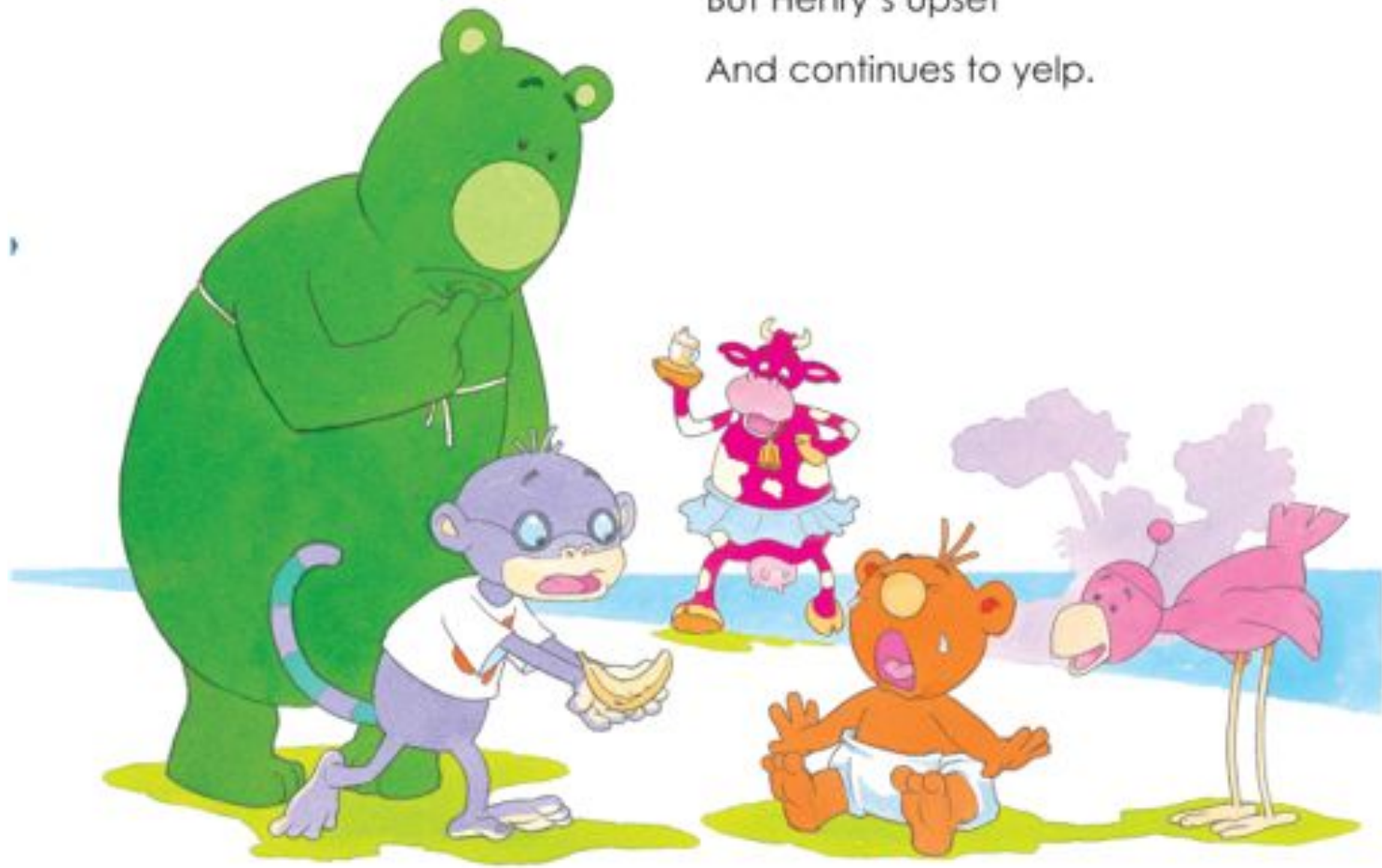


'He's hungry,' says Cheeky.

And continues to yelp.

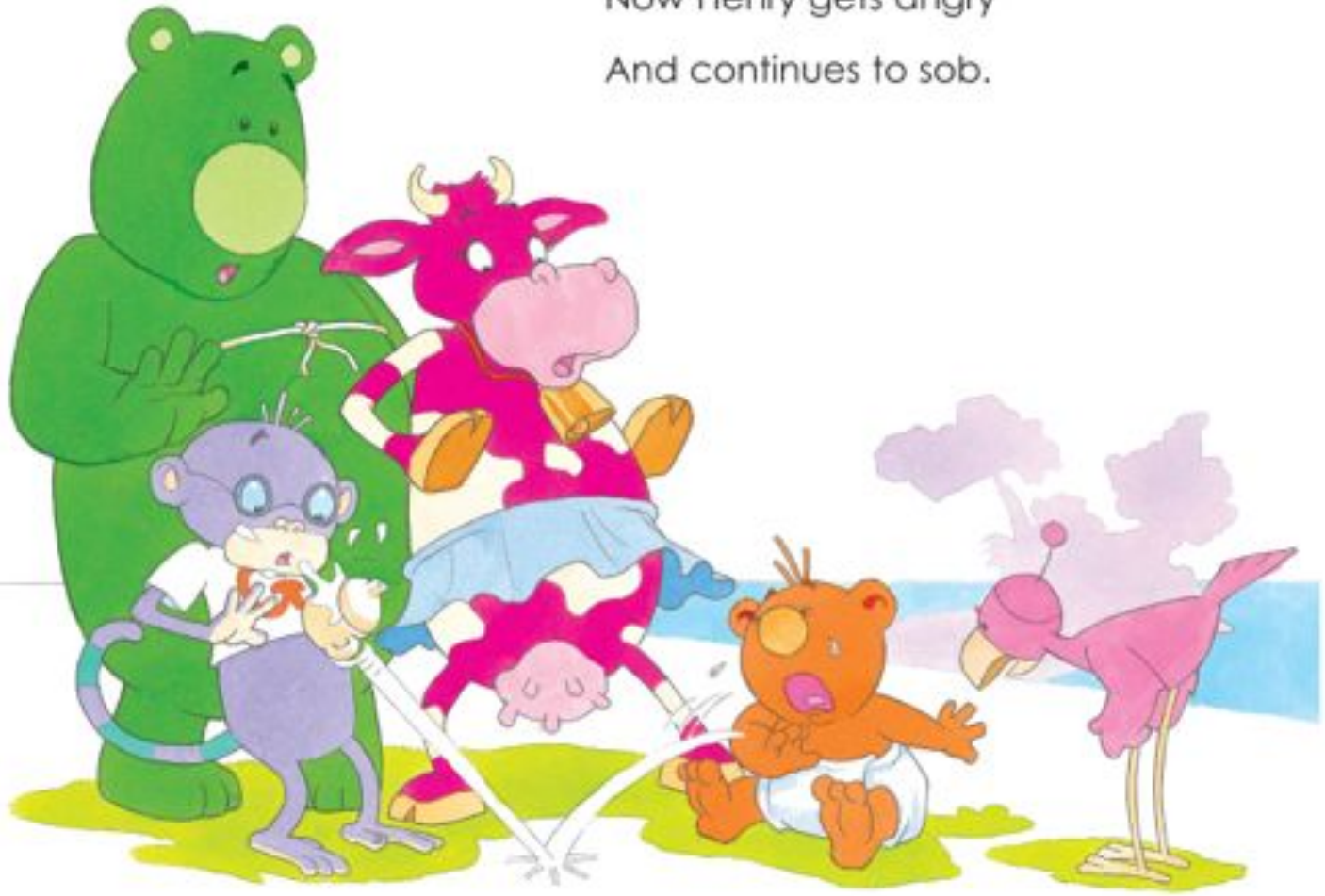


'He's thirsty,' says Moo.

And continues to sob.

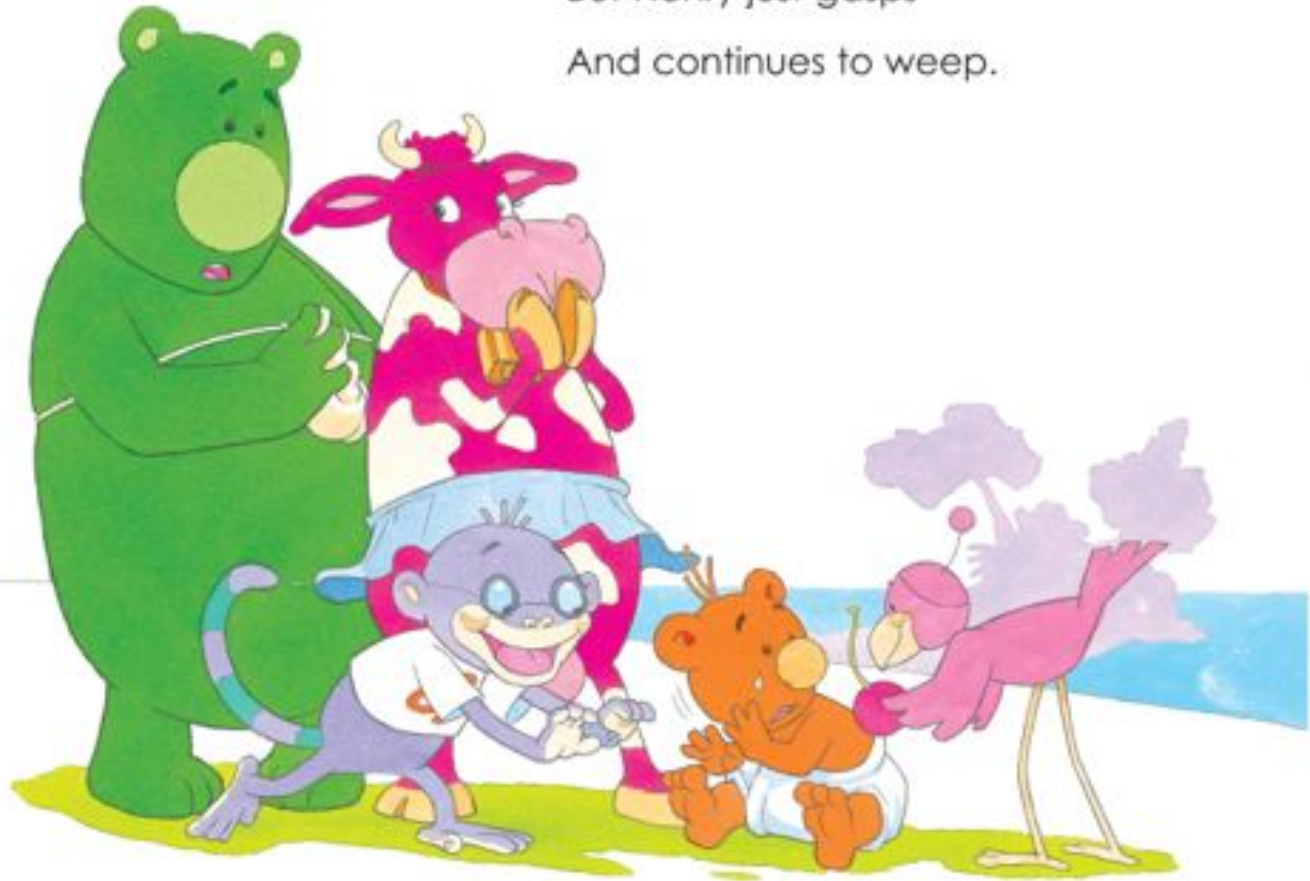


'A cherry will do it,' says Chirpy,
